Since June 2016, Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) has been permitted in Canada. The legislation outlines patient eligibility criteria while establishing safeguards that a Physician or Nurse Practitioner must follow to legally provide Medical Assistance in Dying.

Medical Assistance in Dying is a deeply personal and emotional issue. Bayshore HealthCare ensures that Physicians and patients have access to all the information and support they need in reaching whatever decision they choose.

To provide high quality care for end of life clients, Bayshore has developed a comprehensive solution for our health care partners, health authorities and those seeking support with Medical Assistance in Dying.

We believe patients should, *at all times*, be treated with understanding, compassion and dignity and should be provided with factual, objective information about MAID.

Health care partners and Physicians receive clinical and nursing support as well as pharmacy services and supplies assistance needed to provide end of life services to patients.

Patients and their families have access to an inclusive and caring palliative support and end of life services. Patients will always be treated with understanding, compassion and respect. Their wishes, needs and decisions will be supported and fulfilled.

Bayshore will support patients who decide to pursue Medical Assistance in Dying by ensuring they have care at the chosen date and time in the environment of their choice.
